Family Updates

The Nathaniel Witherell allows family members to visit a Resident’s room and transport to/from the units for outdoor visits.

All families and visitors are required to wear masks when on patient care units. All residents must wear a mask.

Protocols upon arrival in our lobby include:

- Visitors must:
 - Take their temperature.
 - Complete the screening log.
 - Wear the assigned identification sticker.
 - Wear a protective mask when on the unit.

- Then, visitors must:
 - Check in with the floor nurse prior to transporting their loved one off the unit and complete the Sign-Out Log.
 - Complete the Sign-Out Log upon return.
