

COVID UPDATE

There are currently no visiting restrictions. Visitors are encouraged to check notifications posted in the Main Lobby or with their loved one's unit nurse for any changes in visitation protocols.

We are committed to providing care to all residents/patients who are COVID positive and protect those who are currently testing negative. The rights and safety of our residents/patients are our top priority. Therefore, we will continue to follow recommendations and regulations set forth by the CDC, CMS and/or DP.

Protocols for visitors include:

Upon arrival in the Main Lobby, visitors must still have their temperature taken at the kiosk, complete the screening log, and wear the ID sticker.

The visitor must wear a mask if applicable within that unit. Should the visitor be concerned about a possible exposure to a viral infection, a mask should be worn.

All residents/patients, families and visitors will be notified by signage or otherwise, when mask wearing is required (usually during high positivity periods).

Hand hygiene is highly encouraged at all times.

Upon entering the unit, visitors must check-in with the floor nurse prior to transporting their loved one off the floor and complete the sign-out log.

Upon returning the resident/patient to their room/unit, the visitor must again complete the sign-in log within the unit.
